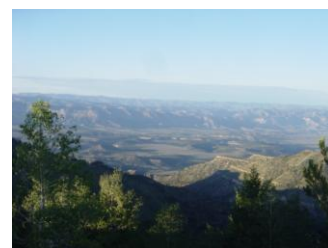
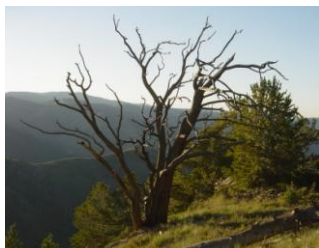

August Club Ride and Meeting Report



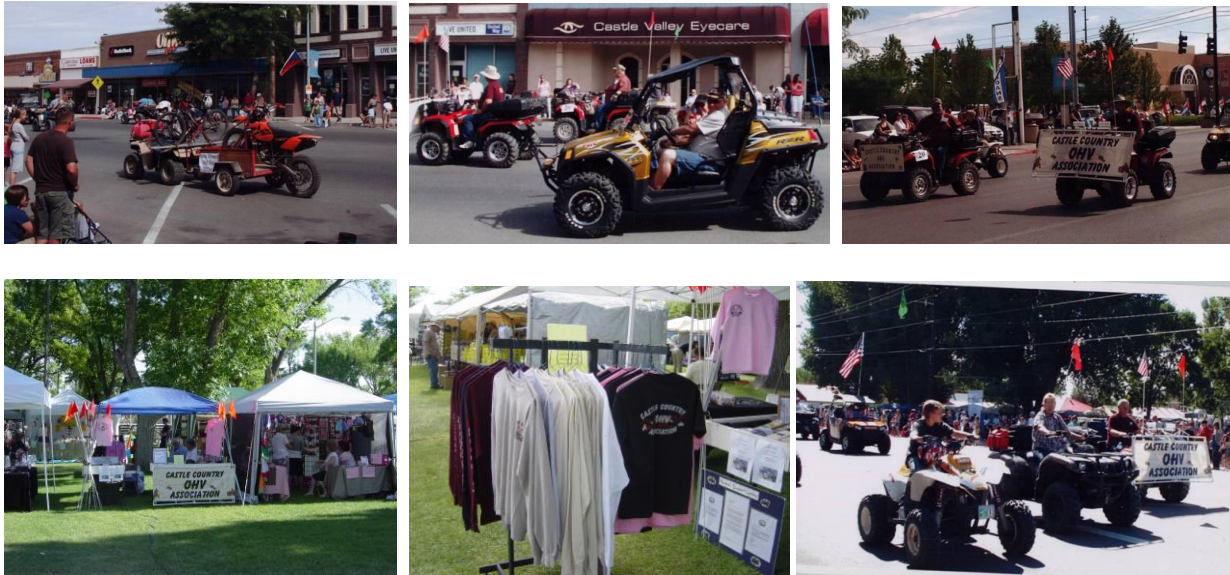

AUGUST 28th 2010, STATE CAPITOL

Last year, 4000 outdoor enthusiasts and multiple use of public land advocates from around the country gathered in Salt Lake to march on the capitol in protest of restrictions placed on Utah's public lands by the Federal government. The protest ignited a string of events that has changed the course and direction of local and state leaders regarding the importance of public land access in the state. 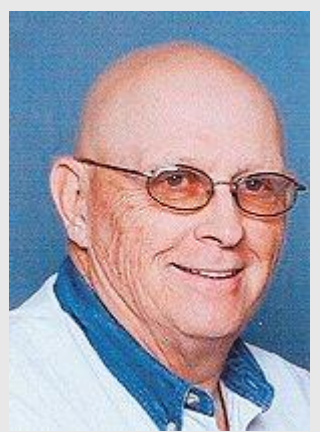
